

Advertisement for a new operator licence

It is your responsibility to advertise your application for an operator's licence in one or more local newspapers which circulate in the locality of each operating centre included in your application. If you do not do this correctly you may face the extra cost and delay of having to re-advertise, or your application may be refused. Please read the following advice carefully and call the contact centre on 0300 123 9000 if you have any queries.

- On the next page is a form that you can use for your advertisement(s)
- If the same newspaper circulates in the locality of all operating centres on your application
 you can include them in the same advertisement. However if one or more of the operating
 centres are not covered by that newspaper then you will need to place additional
 advertisements.
- If you have to include details of more than two operating centres on one advertisement you
 may need to write out your advertisement on a fresh piece of paper.
- When you have filled in the form for the advertisement, tear along the dotted line and send it to a suitable local newspaper. You can download a spare form from https://www.gov.uk/government/collections/hgv-operator-licensing-forms if you need it.
- Examples of completed advertisements are shown below.
- You must send the whole page including the full title and date of the newspaper, which
 contains your advertisement to the central licensing office (CLO). Photocopies are not
 acceptable. If you wish to send your application form to the CLO before you insert your
 advertisement you must send in the whole page containing the advertisement as soon as
 possible.
- Remember: An application must be advertised within 21 days (before or after) of the receipt of your application by the CLO. For example, if the application is received on 1 June, the advertisement must appear in a newspaper on a day between 11 May and 22 June.

Please note in Example 2 certain sections have been crossed through / deleted because they do not apply – this applicant has no trading name and is only including one operating centre in this advertisement.

However the wording at the end of the advertisement must always be included without any changes.
